

PRISM Testing IDs

County submitters may use testing IDs to submit PRISM test files. Testing IDs are three-digit submitter codes; please see the Submitter tab in the <u>PRISM Code Tables</u> for these testing IDs.

Submit test files through the <u>Virtual Room</u>, Compressed_PRISM, same as regular PRISM submissions. The testing ID is the only item that differentiates a test file from a regular PRISM submission.

Summary reports for files submitted with testing IDs will be available to the submitter by the end of the business day after the submission. Summaries will be available through each county's PRISM dashboard.

Each weekday the PRISM team removes test files that have been in the database for over one business day. After the file has been removed, another submission using the same testing ID can be accepted. Test files are not deleted on the weekend, so if you submitted a test file on Friday, it will be deleted on Tuesday morning.

Things to note:

- When submitting with a testing ID, you do not need to let us know to clear your previous submission, since test submissions are deleted once a day
- Test submissions will not impact county submissions made with the two-digit county submitter code
- Test submissions are considered preliminary and cannot be certified
