EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The bill would provide a sales and use tax exemption for materials, supplies, and equipment used in the construction, reconstruction, upgrade, expansion, renovation, or remodeling of certain projects in the Heron Lake-Okabena school district. The projects that would qualify are a roof replacement, concrete work, tuckpointing, windows, flooring, bus garage doors, Heron Lake doors, bathroom fixtures and upgrades, and a pool filter replacement. The exemption would be administered as a refund.

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- Information for the estimates was provided by a representative of the Heron Lake-Okabena school district.
- Total project and construction costs are \$2.4 million.
- Taxable materials are estimated to be \$1 million.
- It is assumed that all refunds will be claimed and paid in fiscal year 2026 based on the project timelines provided.
